

Matthew 27:46 "My God, My God, Why have You forsaken Me?"

Jesus' Thoughts on the Cross

Matthew 27:26 Then he {Pilate} released Barabbas for them; but after having Jesus scourged, he handed Him over to be crucified.

Luke 23:34 But Jesus was saying, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing."

Luke 23:43 And He said to him {the thief on the cross} , "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in Paradise."

John 19:26 He said to His mother, "Woman, behold, your son!"

John 19:27 Then He said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother!"

Matthew 27:46 About the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, Lama Sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, Why have You forsaken Me?"

John 19:28 After this, Jesus, knowing that all things had already been accomplished, to fulfill the Scripture, said, "I am thirsty."

Luke 23:46 And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." Having said this, He breathed His last.

John 19:30 He said, "It is finished"

Psalm 22:1 My God, my God, why have You forsaken me?

Psalm 22:1 Far from my deliverance are the words of my groaning.

Psalm 22:2 O my God, I cry by day, but You do not answer;

Mark 15:33 When the sixth hour came, darkness fell over the whole land until the ninth hour.

Psalm 22:2 And by night, but I have no rest.

Psalm 22:3 Yet You are holy

Psalm 22:4 In You our fathers trusted; They trusted and You delivered them.

Psalm 22:5 To You they cried out and were delivered; In You they trusted and were not disappointed.

Psalm 22:6 But I am a worm and not a man, A reproach of men and despised by the people.

Matt 27:39 And those passing by were hurling abuse at Him, wagging their heads

Psalm 22:7-8 All who see me sneer at me; They separate with the lip, they wag the head, saying, "Commit yourself to the LORD; let Him deliver him; Let Him rescue him, because He delights in him."

Psalm 22:9-10 Yet You are He who brought me forth from the womb; Upon You I was cast from birth; You have been my God from my mother's womb.

Isaiah 53:3 He was despised and forsaken of men, A man of sorrows and acquainted with grief;

And like one from whom men hide their face He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Isaiah 53:4 Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted.

Isaiah 53:5 But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our ~~iniquities~~ **iniquity**; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.

Hebrews 9:22 Without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

Romans 6:23 The wages of sin is death

Hebrews 9:14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to ~~serve~~ **have fellowship with** the living God?

Psalm 22:11 Trouble is near; For there is none to help.
