Division into 5 Sections by Ezra

Genesis 2:4 This is the account of the heavens and the earth when they were created

Genesis 5:1 This is the book of the generations of Adam.

Genesis 10:1 Now these are the records of the generations of Shem, Ham, and Japheth, the sons of Noah

Genesis 11:10 These are the records of the generations of Shem.

Ezra 7:1 Now after these things, in the reign of Artaxerxes king of Persia, there went up Ezra son of Seraiah...

6 This Ezra went up from Babylon, and he was a scribe {textual scholar} skilled in the law of Moses, which the LORD God of Israel had given

10 For Ezra had set his heart to study the law of the LORD and ~~to practice~~ to **compile** it
