#12 Pre-history of the World September 30, 2012

Cain kills Abel, then willfully leaves the presence of the LORD CAIN -- THE PROTOTYPICAL HUMAN BEING

- Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed.
 - **Romans 5:12** Therefore, just as through one man {*i.e.*, male} sin entered into the world ...
- Genesis 4:1 Now the man had relations with his wife Eve, and she conceived and gave birth to Cain, and she said, "I have gotten a manchild, with the help of the LORD."
 - 2 Again, she gave birth to his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of flocks, but and Cain was a tiller of the ground.
 - 3 So it came about <u>in the course of time</u> **after a long period of time** that Cain brought an offering to the LORD of the fruit of the ground.
 - 4 Abel, on his part also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of their fat portions. And the LORD had regard for Abel and for his offering;
 - 5a but for Cain and for his offering He had no regard.
 - **1 Samuel 16:7** God sees not as man sees, for man looks at the outward $\{i.e.$, what comes out $\}$, appearance but the LORD looks at the heart $\{i.e.$, the inner being $\}$.
 - **5b** So Cain became very angry and his countenance fell.
 - 6 Then the LORD said to Cain, "Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen?
 - 7 "If you do well, will not your countenance be lifted up? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it."
 - 8a Cain told said to Abel his brother, { gap in the Hebrew manuscripts} "Let's go out to the field" { Septuagint Reading}
 - **Luke 11:50-51** ...the blood of all the prophets ... from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah
 - **8b** And it came about when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.

1 John 3:12Cain, who was of the evil one and slew his brother. And for what reason did he slay him?

Because his deeds were evil, and his brother's were righteous.

- 9 Then the LORD said to Cain, "Where is Abel your brother?" And he said, "I do not know. —Am I my brother's keeper?" "Am I the keeper's keeper?"
- 10 He said, "What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood is crying to Me from the ground.
- 11 "Now you are cursed from the ground, which has opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand.
- 12 "When you cultivate the ground, it will no longer yield its strength to you; you will be a vagrant and a wanderer on the earth."
- 13 Cain said to the LORD, "My punishment is too great to bear!
- 14 "Behold, You have driven me this day from the face of the ground; and from Your face I will be hidden, and I will be a vagrant and a wanderer on the earth, and whoever finds me will kill me."
- 15 So the LORD said to him, "Therefore whoever kills Cain, vengeance will be taken on him sevenfold." And the LORD appointed a sign for Cain, so that no one finding him would slay him.
- 16 Then Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and settled in the land of Nod, east of Eden.
 - Genesis 3:22 Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, knowing good and evil; and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take also from the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"—
 - 23 therefore the LORD God sent him out from the garden of Eden
 - 24 So He drove the man out; and at the east of the garden of Eden He stationed the cherubim and the flaming sword which turned every direction to guard the way to the tree of life.
- **Colossians 3:3** You have died and your life is hidden {*i.e.*, hidden from view} with Christ in God.
- Galatians 3:27 All of you who were baptized into identified with Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.
