Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our Image, according to Our likeness" *Our Righteousness is by His Decree, NOT our Performance*

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created {"bara"} the heavens and the earth.

- 2 The earth -was became formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep
- 26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness;

and let them rule over the fish $\{i.e., swarmers\}$ of the sea and over the birds $\{i.e., flyers\}$ of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every <u>creeping thing that creeps</u> **moving** thing that **moves** on the earth."

27 God created {"asah"} man in His own image {*i.e.*, photograph}, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

Colossians 1:15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

 Psalm 8:4-5
 What is man that You take thought of him, and the son of man that You care for him? Yet You have made him, -a little
 Yet You have made him, and the angels, and You crown him with glory and majesty!

 Genesis 2:8 The LORD God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed.

- 9 Out of the ground the LORD God caused to grow every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
- 16 17 The LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die dying, you will die.

Rom 8:28 And we know that God causes all things to work together for good
