

True Story: Lazarus & the Rich Man

Isaiah 52:13 He will be high and lifted up and greatly exalted.

Luke 16:19 "Now there was a rich man, and he habitually dressed in purple and fine linen, joyously living in splendor every day.

20-21 And a poor man named Lazarus was laid at his gate, covered with sores, and longing to be fed with the crumbs which were falling from the rich man's table; besides, even the dogs were coming and licking his sores.

22 Now the poor man died and was carried away by the angels to Abraham's bosom {*i.e.*, Abraham's hearth; Paradise};

Luke 23:43 And He said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in Paradise."

and the rich man also died and was buried.

23 In Hades he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom.

Hebrews 9:27 It is appointed for men to die once and after this comes ~~judgment~~ **adjudication**

Jude 12 ...clouds without water... uprooted

13 ... casting up ~~their own shame~~ their own **torment** like foam ... for whom the black darkness has been reserved forever.

24 And he cried out and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus so that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool off my tongue, for I am in agony in this flame.'

25 But Abraham said, 'Child, remember that during your life you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus bad things; but now he is being comforted here, and you are in agony.

26 And besides all this, between us and you there is a great chasm fixed, so that those who wish to come over from here to you will not be able, and that none may cross over from there to us.'

27 -28 And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, that you send him to my father's house- for I have five brothers- in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'

John 1:4 In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men

29 But Abraham said, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.'

Deuteronomy 18:18 I will raise up a prophet from among their countrymen like you, and I will put My words in his mouth...

30 But he said, 'No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!'

31 But he said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead.'"

Ephesians 4:8-9 "When he ascended on high..., Now this expression, "He ascended," what does it mean except that He also had descended into the lower parts of the earth?

2 Corinthians 5:8 we are of good courage ~~,I say,~~ and prefer rather to be absent from the body, ~~and to be~~ at home with the Lord.

Revelation 20:11 Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them.

12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened

Philippians 2:10-11 At the name of Jesus every knee will bow... and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, **due** to the glory of God the Father.

Revelation 20:14 Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death

1 Thessalonians 1:10 and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, that is Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath to come.

I Thess 4:16-17 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord.
