## FAILURE TO CAREFULLY READ THE PASSAGE (Part 2)

## God's Interaction with Believers

- **Job 8:6** If you are pure and upright, surely now He would rouse Himself for you and restore your righteous estate.
- Job 11:13 "If you would direct your heart right and spread out your hand to Him,
  - 14 If iniquity is in your hand, put it far away, and do not let wickedness dwell in your tents;
  - 15 Then, indeed, you could lift up your face without moral defect, and you would be steadfast and not fear.
- **Job 22:7** To the weary you have given no water to drink, and from the hungry you have withheld bread.
  - 9 You have sent widows away empty, and the strength of the orphans has been crushed.
  - 10 Therefore snares surround you, and sudden dread terrifies you,
  - 21 Yield now and be at peace with Him; thereby good will come to you.
  - 23 If you return to the Almighty, you will be restored; if you remove unrighteousness far from your tent
- **Job 42:7** It came about after the LORD had spoken these words to Job, that the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, "My wrath is kindled against you and against your two friends, because you have not spoken of Me what is right."
- Psalm 103:10 He does not treat us as our sins deserve, or repay us according to our iniquities
- **John 16:6** But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart.
  - 7 But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper the Constant Companion {lit. paraclete} will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.
  - 8 And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment

13-14 But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth ... He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you.

**Psalm 51:3** For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.

1 John 3:19-20 We will know by this that we are of the truth, and will assure our heart before Him in whatever our heart condemns us; for God is greater bigger than our heart and knows all things.

**Ephesians 1:13** In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation-having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise

Romans 5:5 The love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are -children sons and daughters of God

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death.

John 14:26 But the Helper the Constant Companion {lit. paraclete}, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

Romans 8:26 In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words inexpressible sighing.
