The Perspicuity of Scripture & Misunderstandings -- Category #6 Misunderstanding the requirement for entry to heaven

- **Romans 7:6** Now we have been released from the Law
- Acts 13:39 Through Him everyone who believes is freed from all things, from which you could not be freed through the Law of Moses
- Colossians 2:13 When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions,
 - 14 having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
- 1 Corinthians 7:19 Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but what matters is keeping of the commandments of God.
- Romans 2:13 for it is not the hearers of the Law who are just before God, but the doers of the Law will be justified.
- Romans 13:9 For this, "YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY, YOU SHALL NOT MURDER, YOU SHALL NOT STEAL, YOU SHALL NOT COVET," and if there is any other commandment, it is summed up in this saying, "YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF."
- Hebrews 4:13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to give an account
- Matthew 12:36 "But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment.
- **Matthew 5:48** "Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect."
- Matt 19:16 And someone came to Him and said, "Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may obtain eternal life?"
 - 17 "... if you wish to enter into life, keep the commandments."

- Matthew 5:19 "Whoever then annuls one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever keeps and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.
 - 20 "For I say to you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven."
- **Philippians 3:9** and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith
- Romans 3:22 ...the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe
- Romans 4:5 But to the one who does not no work, but believes trusts in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness,
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we —might—would become the righteousness of God in Him.
- Colossians 3:3 For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God.
 - 4 When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory
- Romans 14:10 We will all stand beside {"parestesometha"} the judgment seat of God
- **1 Thessalonians 4:1** Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us instruction as to how you ought to walk and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you **excel abound** still more.
- **Philippians 2:12** So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your **own** salvation with fear and <u>trembling</u> **trauma**
 - 13 for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.
