## Patterns established in Eden Nine Benefits of trusting Jesus as Savior

- Genesis 3:14 The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, cursed are you more than all cattle, and more than every beast of the field; on your belly you will go, and dust you will eat all the days of your life;
  - **Romans 8:19** The anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God.
  - And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, and you shall bruise him on the heel."
  - 16 To the woman He said, "In pain you will bring forth children; yet your desire will be for your husband, and he will rule over you."
  - 17 Then to Adam He said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat from it'; Cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you will eat of it All the days of your life.
  - 19 By the sweat of your face You will eat bread, Till you return to the ground, Because from it you were taken; For you are dust, and to dust you shall return."
  - 21 The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.
- **Acts 16:31** "Believe in {*i.e.*, Trust in} the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved"
- **1 John 1:9** If we {*i.e.*, the human race} confess our <u>sins</u> sin, He is faithful and righteous to <u>forgive us</u> erase our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Colossians 1:13-14 For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption
- John 10:28 I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand
  - **1 John 5:13** These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.
- **Romans 8:30** and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified
- I John 4:10 In This is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

Colossians 2:14 having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

**Colossians 1:20** and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him, Whether things on earth or things in heaven

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord

John 19:30 He said, "It is finished!" "Paid in full"

Romans 4:25 He who was delivered over because of for our transgressions, and was raised because of for our justification.

**John 17:16** "They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth

Philippians 3:9 and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith

and may be found in Him, not having **my own** righteousness from **law**, but that which is **by** faith in Christ, the righteousness **of** God **through** {**the instrumentality**} of faith.

Galatians 5:5 For we through the Spirit, by faith, are waiting for the hope of righteousness.

For we are anticipating the certainty of righteousness which comes through the Spirit, by faith

Philippians 2:12 Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling trauma;

Hebrews 12:21 And so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, "I am full of fear and trembling trauma."

- 22-24 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to myriads of angels, to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the Judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant
- for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.

  for God is the one bringing it about in you, both the desire and the doing of what pleases Him

Colossians 2:6 Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him the same way.
