## God hears, "I ate." -- NOT Excuses!

- **Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
  - 2 The earth was became formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep
  - 26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping things that creeps moving thing that moves on the earth."
  - 27 God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.
- Genesis 2:8 The LORD God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed.
  - 9 Out of the ground the LORD God caused to grow every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
  - 16-17 The LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it —you will surely die—dying, you will die."
- Genesis 1:5 God called the light day, and the darkness He called night
  - **8** God called the expanse heaven.
  - 10 God called the dry land earth, and the gathering of the waters He called sea
- Genesis 2:19 Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the sky, and brought them to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called a living creature, that was its name.
  - 20 The man gave names to all the cattle, and to the birds of the sky, and to every beast of the field, but for Adam there was not found a helper suitable for him a companion complementary to him.
  - 21-23 So the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and he slept; then He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh at that place. The LORD God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man. The man said, "This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman {literally, "Ishshah"}, because she was taken out of Man {literally, "Ish"}.
- Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more <u>crafty</u> intelligent than any {other} beast of the field which the LORD God had made.

  And he said to the woman, "Indeed, has God said, 'You shall not eat from any tree of the garden'?"

- **2-3** The woman said to the serpent, "From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat; but from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat from it or touch it, or you will die."
- **4-5** The serpent said to the woman, "You surely will not die "Surely you will not die! For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God as the gods, knowing good and evil."
  - **Isaiah 14:13-14** "I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, and I will sit on the mount of assembly in the recesses of the north. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High."
- 6 When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate.
  - Romans 4:15 Where there is no law, there also is no violation— Sin is not imputed when there is no law.
- 7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loin coverings.
- 8 They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.
- **9** Then the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, "Where are you?"
- 12 The man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me from the tree, and I ate."
- 13 Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" And the woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."
- 21 The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.
